1 belongs to a Murder case. It was collected but sex assault ultimately not part of the case.

1 belongs to a fugitive outside the US

7 were no auctioned by the District Attorney.

4 Victims declined to prosecute.

7 Were unfounded for a variety of reasons.

6 cases are listed as open and kits have yet to be transferred to the lab.

2 kits were taken by our agency for crimes in other jurisdiction and those agencies have not requested the transfer of the evidence.
