Below please find that your IPRA request [dated March 23rd, 2015](#) has been fulfilled and is closed.

- We currently have 1182 sexual assault kits in our evidence inventory dating back to 2006.
- 835 do not have a request for service.
- Out of the remaining 347, 143 kits still need to be tested and 204 have been tested and are awaiting either adjudication of a suspect match/identification.
- This number is fluid as we are constantly receiving new cases and testing existing kits.
