Dear [Redacted],

Ms. Downing (from the prosecutor's office) called me back and stated that (1) she understood that the matter will be handled by the Trenton Police, (2) there was no backlog in testing of rape kits in cases prosecuted against a suspect by the prosecutor's office, and (3) she did not have any information as to whether the Trenton Police Department had a backlog with respect to collected rape kits.

I followed up with Detective Durlacher of the Trenton Police department and she stated that (1)the Trenton Police Department collects but does not test any rape kits, and (2) the Trenton Police Department sends the kits to the New Jersey State Police to be tested. Both Ms. Downing and Detective Durlacher stated that there was no documentation which kept track of the number kits collected and tested. Detective Durlacher advised me to file the enclosed OPRA requests with the City Clerk and New Jersey State Police.

Unless I hear from you to the contrary I will file the enclosed OPRA requests on Wednesday.

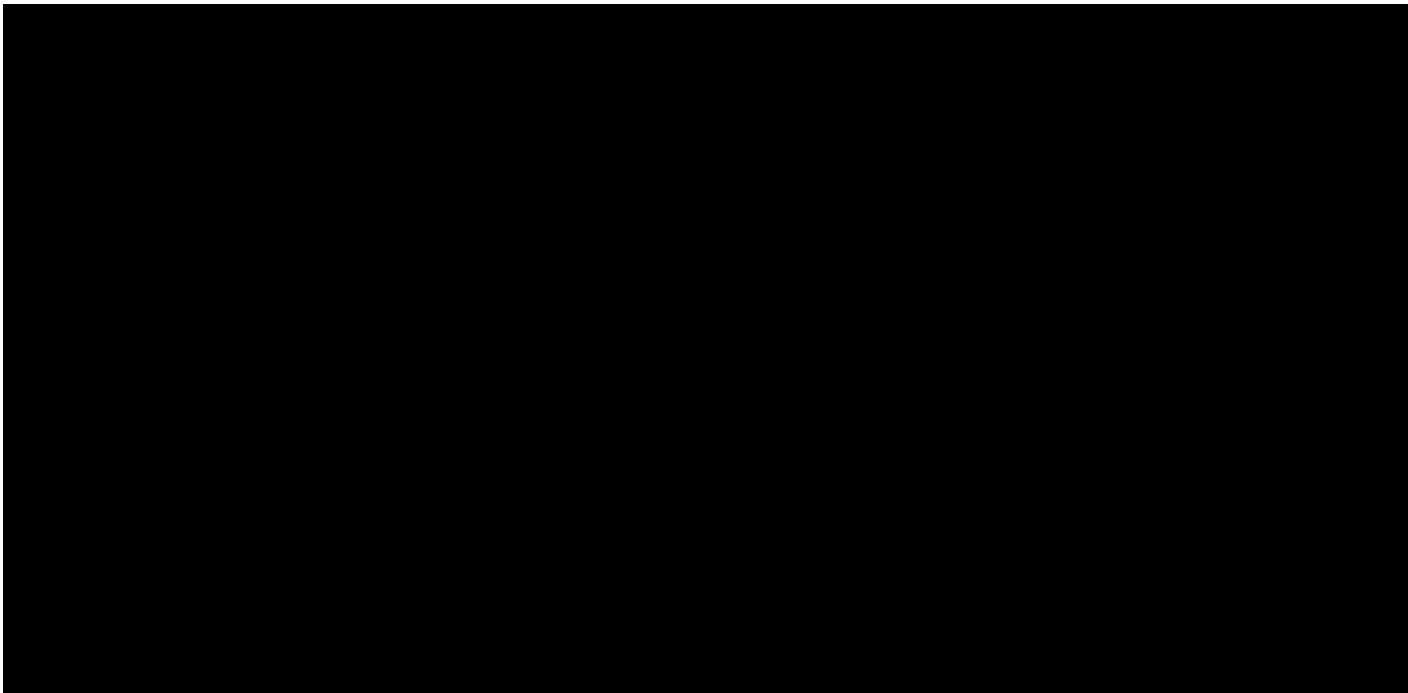

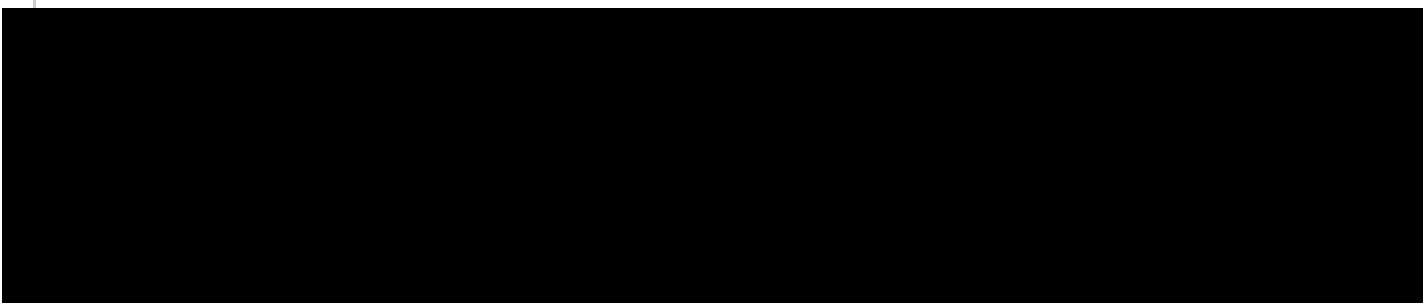
